- As this will be an event catered to families, all arts and crafts items sold at the ethnic festival must not contain any objects or pictures which may be deemed profane or obscene by the general public.
- Sale of alcohol will be prohibited.
- On the day of the event, all festival cosponsors must be set up and ready by 11:00 A.M.
